The CHCMRC Unit is actively seeking volunteers – medical and non-medical to assist in these areas:

- Point of Dispensing (POD) Task Force
- Functional and Access Needs Task Force
- Leadership Task Force

WHY: Major emergencies can overwhelm the capabilities of local responders, particularly during the first 12-72 hours and MRC volunteers can help meet that need.

WHO: Any medical or non-medical volunteers wishing to assist with emergency preparedness and response efforts. All volunteers must be at least 18 years old.

HOW: All CHCMRC volunteers must register through the Ohio Responds System. www.Ohioresponds.gov
